Admission includes free pre-game music and program at 5:00 p.m.






WRAP GRANT

The Sam Bomar Scholarship Fund (a fund of West Tennessee Healthcare Foundation) has awarded a \$1000 grant to help meet the educational needs of children who either receive services directly through Wo/Men's Resource and Rape Assistance Program's (WRAP) sexual assault therapy program or who are the children of clients served by WRAP. Through its domestic violence program, WRAP annually serves over 600 children, ranging in age from one day up to seventeen years of age. All services are free of charge.

Mothers receiving services from WRAP often have financial difficulties in meeting many of the educational needs of their children. Last year, WRAP furnished uniforms to seventy-seven school age children. Additionally, other educational necessities such as tutoring, school activity fees, and supplies were provided by WRAP. However, WRAP lacks adequate funding to provide all the "extras" that are needed. The Sam Bomar grant will help alleviate the hardship suffered by children who, through no fault of their own, have been uprooted to live in a different location and often to attend a different school. Priority will be given to the educational needs of seniors in high school or who are themselves receiving services from WRAP.

Faith and Fellowship Award in memory of Dylan Kirk \$1000



Dylan, son of Scott and Cindy Kirk, was called home to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Sunday, March 11, 2012, at the age of eighteen. In addition to his parents, he is survived by two brothers, Holden and Grayson.

Dylan was a 2011 graduate of Trinity Christian Academy and was a member of the first TCA baseball team to qualify for the state tournament. He was an All-District player and was selected to the West Tennessee All-Star squad that played an exhibition at Pringle's Park. Dylan was a member of three Madison County Dixie youth baseball teams which qualified for the state tournament. At the time of his death, he was a freshman at the University of Tennessee Chattanooga, where he was majoring in pre-law. Dylan was an active member of Fellowship Student Ministries at Fellowship Bible Church of Jackson. During high school, he was active in his school's Young Life Group.
