

**Sam Bomar Scholarship**  
**(A Fund of West Tennessee Healthcare Foundation)**  
**Madison Academic High School Requirements 2012**

One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a senior graduating from Madison Academic High School and one \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a senior graduating from another high school located in Madison County.

Requirements:

Accepted by either a two or four-year college or university in the state of Tennessee

Public Service Major (e.g., Education, Criminal Justice, Law Enforcement, Social Work, Christian or Bible Studies or the Ministry)

Minimum of a B Average (3.00) and 23 on the ACT

The student's level of involvement in extracurricular and community activities will be given the greatest weight, especially scouting, church work, volunteer service, and creative arts activities (drama, speech, forensics, music, visual art).

For the Madison student, a minimum of ten (10) hours of service to Madison is required as verified by Madison's Parent Support Group.
